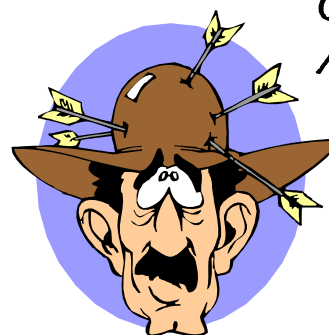
The Judges Clinic had a new format and I learned a lot from them. Thank you all.
