## BECOMING AN ALBERTA PROVINCIAL ARCHERY JUDGE

In Alberta Provincial Judges are required to pass two levels of Certification:

**Provincial Judge Technical  
Provincial Judge Practical**

In order to become fully qualified

### **PROVINCIAL JUDGE TECHNICAL**

- register for a Judges Clinic
- complete Local Judge Questionnaires
  - FITA (Indoor/Outdoor, Olympic Rounds, Field and 3D)
- attend a Judges Clinic
- achieve 80% or better on Clinic material and Case Study presentations. (a mark of 50% - 80% is Local Judge standing)

### **PROVINCIAL JUDGE PRACTICAL**

- judge with Provincial Judges for at least on Indoor and one Outdoor season
- show a working knowledge of the Rules and receive satisfactory evaluations
- judge a minimum of
  - i) three Indoor FITAs
  - ii) three Outdoor FITAs
  - iii) one FITA Field
  - iv) one 3D

From ATAA, Provincial Judges receive travel costs, accommodation and a per diem as do Provincial Judge Candidates.



Clubs holding shoots give an honorarium of \$20.00 per day to the Provincial Judge(s).
